



# **Commercial Design Guidelines - Notice of Public Open House**

A Public Open House is being held to introduce and present the Town's draft work towards establishing Commercial Site and Architectural Design Guidelines along 50<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

This Open House will allow interested residents an opportunity to come and go over the course of the evening to review the draft Design Guidelines. Representatives of the project's Steering Committee (comprised of residents and participating Town Councilors), and the Town's planning consultant will be present to explain, answer questions, and receive input.

All residents are invited and encouraged to attend the Public Open House to be held:

The Design Guidelines are intended to identify and require desirable site and architectural considerations be implemented to ensure that individual projects contribute positively to development along 50<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Ultimately, the Design Guidelines will be required to be enacted through an amendment to the Town's existing Land Use Bylaw, and this process requires three readings from Town Council. Prior to the second reading of the amending bylaw, Town Council would advertise and hold a public hearing to allow affected members of the public to speak directly to Council on the matter.

## April 2012

For the month of April the Alberta Traffic Safety plan is focusing on speed enforcement. With the roads clearing up and spring here, more people will be on the roads. Remember that in Calmar all of the road speed limits are 30 km/h with the exception of Highway 39 (50 Avenue) and Highway 795 (50 Street south of 50 Avenue) and 44 Avenue which are 50 km/h.

You will see an increase in pedestrian traffic, joggers, bikers, skate boarders, etc., so be very mindful of your speed and the pedestrian crossings. This includes driving down back alleys and side roads where children are most likely to be outside playing.

Since 2007 the amount of traffic fatalities has declined by 25%, injuries declined 26%, and fatalities involving high rates of speed dropping by 21%. This has been a trend for the last 5 years and we hope it continues. Have a safe and enjoyable spring!
