



DEVON PIONEER73 APRIL 13, 2017 7:00 PM - 9:00 PM Come enjoy an evening learning about Birds of Prey in Devon. In particular, "Owls and Owl Conservation in Alberta". Jointly presented by the Devon Nature Club and Pioneer 73. Live Owl in Attendance!

Dr. Gordon Court is a professional ornithologist and presently the Provincial Wildlife Status Biologist for the Fish and Wildlife Division, Government of Alberta. Over his career he has studied breeding biology and toxicology of birds—from Penguins to peregrine falcons. He has also studied forestdwelling owls in the boreal forest of Canada and is formerly Canadian Director of the US-based Raptor research Foundation.

Dr. Court's presentation will discuss species in our area, territorial, feeding and nesting requirements; why they are important to the surrounding ecosystem; our community and society as a whole; why are Birds of Prey protected by the *Alberta Wildlife Act*; how can a community ensure they stay and thrive...?




