

GARDENING TIP:

Osteospurmums, or commonly known as african daisies will bloom all summer long if planted in full sun to part shade, watered with 1" water at least once a week and fertilized once every 2-3 weeks. They don't need to be deadheaded other than to keep them tidy. They are usually hybrid so don't have seeds, but can be grown from cuttings. They come in a variety of colours and grow about 12" high. Great for planters.

FIRE BAN INFORMATION

TOTAL FIRE BAN

A <u>Total Fire Ban</u> occurs when the fire hazard in the area is VERY HIGH to EXTREME. Large erratic-behaving wildfires can start quickly and spread extremely fast, through dry grass or slash. This type of fire could escalate with any type of wind. <u>NO OUTDOOR BURNING OF ANY KIND IS TO OCCUR DURING A TOTAL FIRE BAN.</u>

PARTIAL FIRE BAN

A <u>Partial Fire Ban</u> occurs when the fire hazard in the area is HIGH to VERY HIGH. Wildfires can start easily from most causes especially unattended campfires and cooking fires. Wildfires may become serious and difficult to control if not successfully contained while small. <u>OUTDOOR BURNING IS ONLY PERMITTED IN APPROVED FIRE PITS OR APPROVED BURNING</u>

APPLIANCES.

FIRE ADVISORY

A <u>Fire Advisory</u> occurs when the fire hazard in the area is MODERATE to HIGH. Wildfires can start from most accidental causes and spread moderately through dry brush and grasses. Fire Crews should be able to contain a wildfire with minimal support. Wildfires not suppressed immediately can still become very serious fires. <u>OUTDOOR BURNING IS PERMITTED ONLY WITH A FIRE PERMIT OR IN AN APPROVED FIRE PIT OR BURNING APPLIANCE</u>.

NO FIRE BAN

A <u>No Fire Ban</u> occurs when the fire hazard in the area is LOW to MODERATE. Wildfires do not readily ignite, unless from a more intense heat source such as lightning. Weather and fuel conditions lead to a low intensity and make it relatively easy to control fires. Caution should always be taken with any type of burning.

OUTDOOR BURNING IS PERMITTED ONLY WITH A FIRE PERMIT OR IN AN APPROVED FIRE PIT OR BURNING
APPLIANCE
