PLEASE BE ADVISED OF THE FOLLOWING:

TRAFFIC SAFETY

Due to numerous calls and walk up complaints regarding safety concerns at the Esso/Co-op corner, I have been monitoring and ticketing all safety violations noted in that general area. With the warmer weather and sunny days, speed has picked up coming and leaving town. Pedestrian Crossings at that corner has been of concern because of this increase in speed. Motor vehicles that travel thru the activated lights or while a pedestrian is waiting to cross, have and will continue to be ticketed. The fine for failing to stop for a pedestrian is \$776.00. I have been using a lesser charge of failing to obey a traffic control device, \$233.00. That discretion will no longer occur as the number of infractions at that crossing, as well in all areas of safety at that corner are on the rise. Speeding/ Large Tractor trailer parking in no parking zones/ Crossing infractions/ etc. will be ticketed accordingly with no lowering of fines or other past discretion.

UNSIGHTLY PROPERTIES AND LAWN MAINTENANCE

Lawn care season is once again upon us. Please be mindful that each home or land owner is responsible to maintain their property in a proper manner. <u>ALL UNSIGHTLY PROPERTIES</u> and unkept lawn maintenance will be fined and the Town will send in Calmar Public Works to clean/cut/ or, make orderly those properties which choose to not follow the unsightly/weed control/related bylaws. That cost will then be added to the owners tax roll.
