**ST. PATRICK'S DAY - March 17 -** St. Patrick's feast day was being celebrated by the Irish in the ninth and tenth centuries - it was placed on the universal liturgical calendar in the Catholic Church in the early 1600's. It then became a holy day of obligation for Roman Catholics in Ireland. In the Church of Ireland it remains a Feast Day. It became an official Irish public holiday in 1903. The government of the Republic of Ireland began campaigning to use St. Patrick's Day to showcase Ireland and it's culture in the mid-

Energy Your Way<sup>™</sup>: FortisAlberta's Energy Your Way<sup>™</sup> Earth Hour Challenge was a huge success last year with 11 municipalities competing to save the most electricity in FortisAlberta's service territory. Participants saved a total of 10 MW, which is enough to power 11,000 houses for one hour! Earth Hour is a global event that takes place in March each year with the goal of encouraging people and businesses to turn off unnecessary lights, appliances and electronic devices to help conserve power and protect the planet.

Due to a high level of interest in the program last year, FortisAlberta is adding two additional grants in 2015 to support this project. These are available to municipalities in our service territory that have a franchise agreement\* with FortisAlberta. The grant is designed to help communities with activities such as retrofitting facilities with LED/CFL bulbs or to improve the energy efficiency of heating and cooling units in public facilities.






