At the conclusion of the ceremony, Calmar Legion will host a short talk on the importance of Vimy Day with speakers who attended the 100th Anniversary of this WW 1 battle. This battle is known as the Coming of Age for Canada as it was the first time any British Commonwealth country was allowed to be led by their own Generals. There will also be a brief mention on the importance of VE Day.

Following the talks, we will be doing our annual Honors and Awards with monetary awards going out to various local individuals, groups and organizations. The students with their winning entries for essay, poetry and artwork will also be awarded their prize at this time.




