

### **Christmas Lights Competition**


The Town of Calmar Recreation Board will be running the Winter Lights Competition again this year.



## Town of Calmar Changes to Waste & Blue Bag Collection



Waste and Blue Bag Collection is moving to FRONT CURB ONLY

### ALL COLLECTION WILL NOW OCCUR AT THE FRONT CURB

To maintain alleyways and overhead lines, all collection in the Town of Calmar will now be from the front street. Starting November 1st, 2012, waste and blue bag collection will occur from the front curb ONLY.

#### New Waste Carts are Coming In October

Starting on November 1st, garbage will be collected from new rolling waste carts.

Rolling waste carts will be delivered to your homes, without cost to residents or the Town of Calmar, during the 2nd week of October. Look for more information to arrive in your mailbox.

The new rolling waste cart program will ensure cleaner garbage pick-up with less wind-blown debris, greater efficiency and fewer injuries for handlers.

Every Thursday starting November 5, 2012, only waste inside the new rolling waste carts will be collected.

Blue bags will continue to be collected on every second Monday. Do NOT use waste carts for blue bags



### PROPER CART PLACEMENT

### Front Street (by 7 AM)

- Bag all waste before placing in cart.
- Do not overfill, lids must close properly.
- 3 Handles to the sidewalk.
- 4.1 M (4 ft.) around all carts, including overhead.
