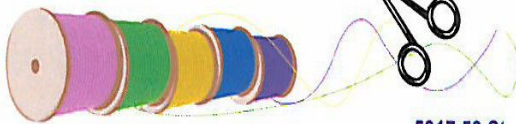

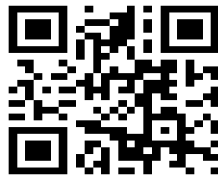

TOWN OF CALMAR EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY CUSTODIAL SERVICES

The Town of Calmar requires an employee, to provide custodial services primarily for the Town Administration Building with some incidental occasional cleaning at the Town Fire Hall and Calmar Community Hall. The person will be employed for three (3) days each week, Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 8am to 10am (time of employment may be negotiable).
