The Calmar Fair Bench Show took place on August 16 at the Calmar Curling Arena. As the organizing committee, we're pleased to reflect on the success we experienced this year. Those who have been in and around Calmar long enough will remember that we used to have a bench show up until the 1990's. Sadly, interest faded, and for a time Calmar was without a proper fair. After a 10+ year dormancy, the Calmar Fair Bench Show was resurrected in 2008 by Bob McKerracher and Linda Vander Veen. For the first few years, the bench show was held in the Scout Hall south of Main Street. In 2010, the Fair moved to the Calmar Curling Arena and things have been looking up ever since. Each year has seen a marked improvement over the year before.

This year has been another banner year! Compared to last year, the number of exhibits increased by 70% while participation was up by a staggering 93%! Furthermore, hundreds of fair-goers toured the exhibit hall during Saturday's public showcase.

Competition was divided by age and categories. Overall point leaders in each of those categories were awarded plaques in recognition of their achievement. Our overall winners for Junior, Intermediate, Teen, and Adult age groups were Owen Rennie, Carol, Megan Froese, and Nolene Boender respectively. The adult age group was broken down further into baking (Linda Vander Veen), Gardening (JP Vander Veen), Handicrafts (Una Thompson), and Photography (Rebecca Oosterhoff). Congratulations!

We want to extend a heartfelt thanks to partners, sponsors, and everyone who participated this year! When we look at other fall fairs and bench shows across Canada and the Prairies, we're inspired to continue developing this into something that will put Calmar on the map!
