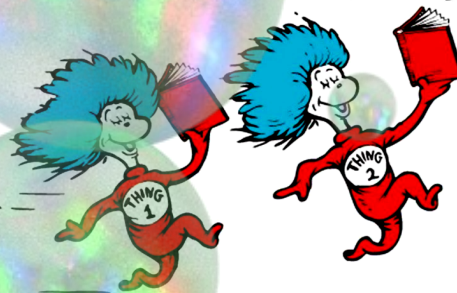

I would also like to extend a special thank you to the awesome Volunteers, Public Works, Recreation, Fire Department and Peace Officer for their tremendous efforts, as always!

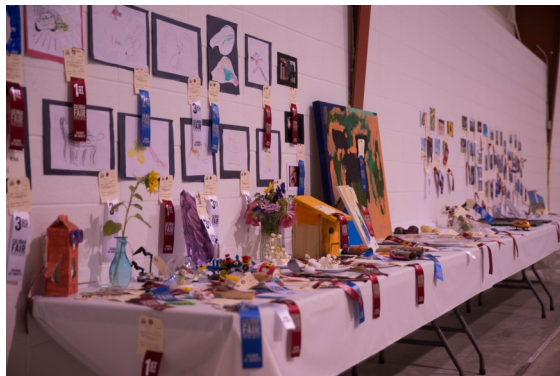

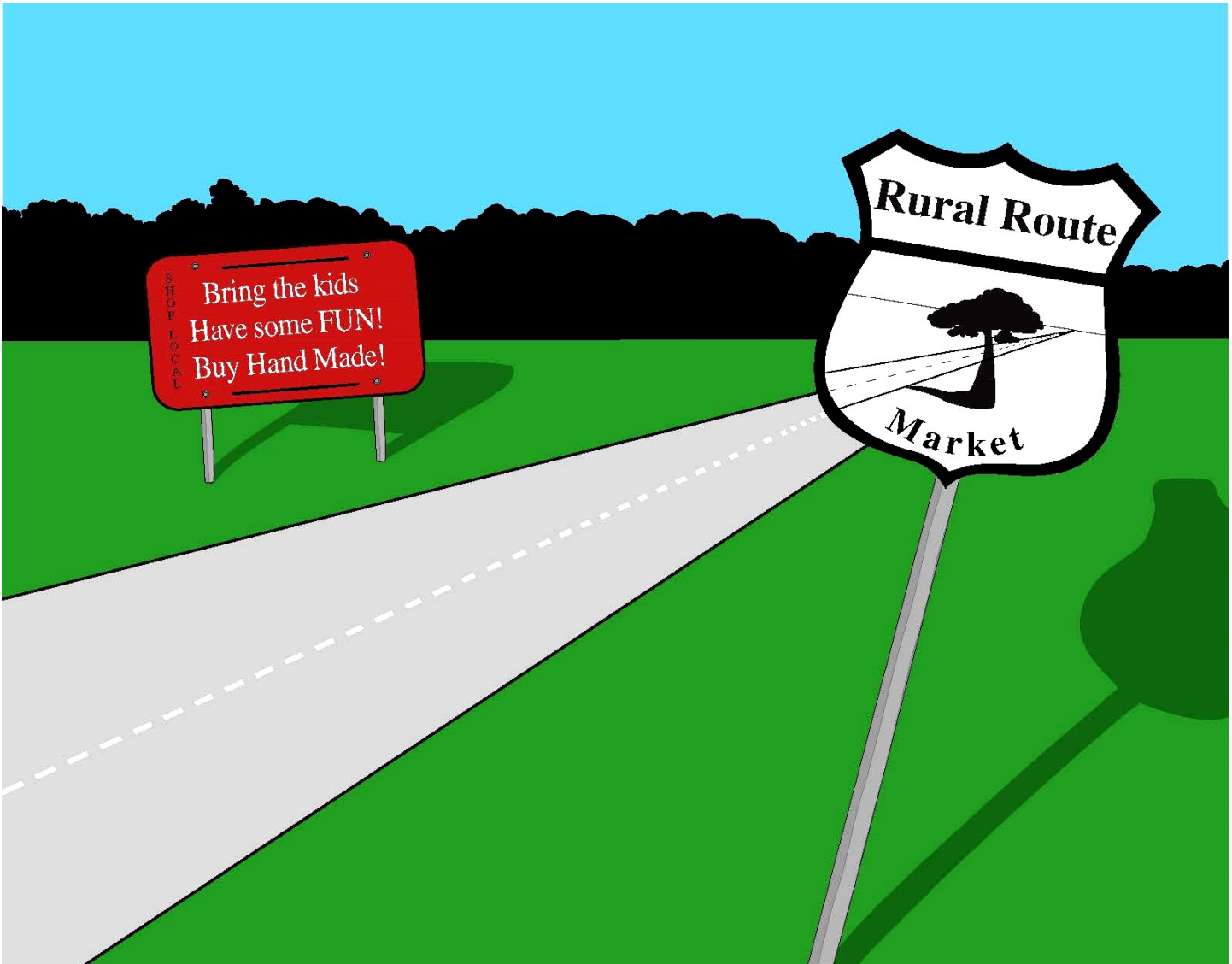

Alberta ZIRKA Ukrainian Performers

Celebrating 40 years of culture, artistry and Ukrainian Dance

The Alberta Zirka Ukrainian Performers are excited to celebrate their 40th anniversary this year. Zirka was founded as the Calmar School of Ukrainian Dance in 1975 by a handful of visionary families interested in maintaining their Ukrainian heritage and culture through dance. Over 450 dancers from Calmar and the surrounding communities of Leduc, Devon, Thorsby, Warburg, Beaumont, Millet, Drayton Valley and Edmonton have developed and shared their talents through the organization since its inception.

Under the artistic direction of Dave Ganert, Zirka strives to create a fun and respectful Ukrainian dance environment that is inspirational, educational, and encourages a spirit of interest in Ukrainian dance and culture. Zirka offers a professional dance program that follows a syllabus of Ukrainian dance study beginning at age 3 to adult class.

Zirka's 40th anniversary year will feature multiple events including a Comedy Night! on Friday, November 27, 2015 at the Devon Community Centre. Doors open 6:30pm, show 8:00pm and a DJ dance to follow at 9:30pm. Zirka's 40th Anniversary Banquet will include dinner, a live Ukrainian band and a dance performance from the entire organization. A special alumni dance will be featured during the evening. This wonderful occasion will be held at the Meridian Banquet Centre in Edmonton on April 16, 2016. The 40th anniversary year will culminate with a finale performance on Saturday, May 7, 2016 held at the Maclab Theatre for Performing Arts in Leduc. Tickets can be purchased through ticketpro in the spring.

Zirka is hosting registration for their programs on Wednesday, September 2 from 4:30-7:00pm at the Zirka Studio located at 4920-50 avenue, Calmar and on Thursday, September 3 from 6:30-8:00pm at Calmar Elementary School.

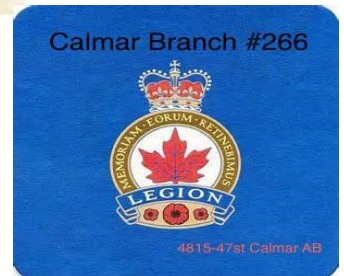
