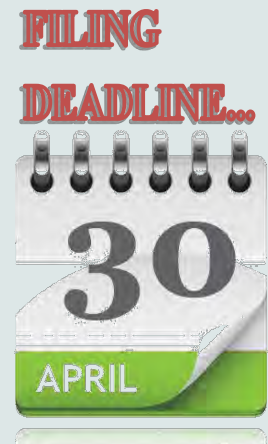
Who can CVITP help?

I have not written a Mayor's Corner for a couple of months. The winter season was extremely quiet and there was not a lot to report on. As always if anyone has any question about the workings of the Town you can contact me or any of the Councilors and ask your questions.

It was reported the Hotel would be removed by the end of January. As we all can see it is still standing. Administration is still working with the owner of the building and hopefully the building will be removed shortly.

There is a bus service for everyone 18 years of age and older (17 years and younger if accompanied by an adult) to use. The bus comes to Town on the first and third Thursdays of the month, at 10:20 am, at the Senior's Center. The cost is \$7.00 round trip to Leduc. It will take people to the Doctor's and shopping. If we do not use it, we may lose it.

Spring has sprung and Council is working on the 2016 budget and should have it completed by the end of April. Why we are so late in finalizing the budget? It has to do with working on a new contract for the Emergency Services delivery for the Town and the County. We have not come to a final decision on which direction we will proceed with this service. Also, the Provincial Government has not yet released the amount required for the School Requisition for 2016.

Next month after negotiations are completed with the County on Emergency Services delivery, I will release all of the information on both contracts to the Community so you have a balanced point of view to make your decision on which way Council should proceed with this issue. Until negotiations are complete, neither I nor Council can discuss this issue. Please wait until we release all of the information before you make your decision as to which direction we need to proceed.
