Council worked hard to keep our mill rates as low as possible this year while continuing to work towards our level of service goals, increase communications and relations with our business community and to continue to market Calmar as a place to be. Reminder to all that taxes are due by June 30th to avoid late penalty. If you want to be on the monthly payment plan please reach out to the office to be setup.

Check out the town website and social media posting for the many upcoming summer events. We have summer camp programs for the children and youth, there will be a new Canada celebration in Calmar this year with many items and of course the always popular Calmar days in August. Summer is just around the corner, and we notice that more residents are outside enjoying their yards. Doing this in a safe and respectful manner to your neighbours, friends, and family should always be a high priority. To ensure that residents can enjoy their yards, we ask that everyone, which includes owners and renters, do their part.

The Town of Calmar Land Use Bylaw regulates objects prohibited or restricted in yards (section 7.17 of the bylaw). The bylaw dictates that no person shall keep in any yard in residential district any objects that are deemed unsightly by the Development Authority. The purpose of this section is to ensure that yards are aesthetically pleasing, safe, and enjoyable. Having cleaned and well-maintained yards also reduces the opportunity for pests and wildlife to establish themselves on your property and facilitates the elimination of noxious weeds.

I have driven around town on many occasions, and I have to say that most properties have clean, well-kept yards. These properties reflect well on their residents. A great kudos to all those residents for being great neighbours and great ambassadors for Calmar.

Unfortunately, there are a few properties where various types of objects/materials (such as tarps, parts, equipment, gears, garbage, lumber, pipes, etc.) are located all over the yard. Sometime, these objects/materials can be blown by the wind onto other properties in the area. The town has been receiving complaints about unsightly yards in the last few weeks and will be preparing an enforcement strategy to ensure that the bylaw is being followed.

If you have any items/objects on your property that you need to dispose of, please remember that you can always bring these to the landfill and/or the Eco Station in Leduc, pending what the items/objects are. Selling some of your extra items/materials is also a popular option I have been told.

Over the next few days, we will use our website and social media to communicate more information about yard management/maintenance and the enforcement strategy. Should you have any questions, do not hesitate to reach out to the Town Hall.

Good day Town of Calmar

Winter is finally gone, and the warmer weather has arrived. With that comes some needed upkeep with our homes and responsibilities with our pets.

The snow had covered yard issues that this warmer weather has now uncovered. Unsightly properties need to be looked after as well as the dog feces that was buried in snow. Please make sure to use this warm weather to address these issues that will only cause future problems.

With respects to warmer weather and pets. Pet complaints are off the charts. Dog bites, dogs barking, dog at large, dogs off leash while off owner property, cats at large, cats in flower beds. The first two weeks of May brought in over 100 calls for service. When the question is asked if I have better things to do than deal with pet and unsightly concerns, the answer is YES, but I can't deal with more pressing concerns when the volume of animal and yard complaints are taking up my time.

Fires are always a concern at this time of year. We had a fair size fire at the east side of Calmar that could have easily turned into a problem had it not been for the quick response of Leduc County Fire, and the help of a dozer in the area. If a fire ban and OHV ban is posted, these need to be respected as we ban these for the safety of the town. To those who choose to ignore and flaunt their contravention to these bans, I look forward to seizing your OHV, writing large penalty violation tickets, or adding to your to do list by sending you to court. To those who understand the need for such action and help keep this town safe by adhering to these bans, I want to thank you for your help in ensuring our town is not the next one to be evacuated.


