Happy birthday to our great country from coast to coast. I feel so privileged to live in this great nation with all people of different diversity and ethnicity. A country with beautiful lands, freedoms and many services for all to enjoy.

Reminder to all to adventure out on July 1 and see the First Annual Canada Cup Street Hockey Tournament. Come on down, there will be a free pancake breakfast and all kinds of fun for all ages, including a dunk tank that will include the mayor.

As the summer sun peaks its heads out of the clouds, I am starting to see the RV units becoming a welcome site as people are beginning to enjoy the season. Just a reminder to be respectful of our neighbours and other users of the roads. There are special rules relating to parking units on the streets. Please be familiar with these rules so we can all enjoy a great summer.

Construction has started on the sanitary line replacement from Highway 39 North on 51 street to 51 avenue and East to 50 street. Phase 1 will be from 50 street along 51 avenue to 51 street. Phase 2 will be from 51 avenue South to highway 39. Notices were distributed on June 9th to all affected properties. It is very disheartening that people took to social media to discuss how they were unhappy with the notification process and that the Town was not providing alternative parking. This project is estimated to cost nearly \$1.1 million dollars and is a big project for our community.

We have seen an increase in communication with the Council and the Town on social media which is a welcome sight. We do request everyone with a concern, a suggestion and any inquiry to reach out to the Town office and work with administration in a positive, professional and calm manner. This approach will yield a far more productive conversation with viable compromise and solutions. Remember we are a small town with limited resources at our finger tips and sometimes the cost of solutions or new ideas may not be cost prohibitive to our community.

Calmar Fair Days will be back this August 18-20. Ball tournament, Mega Market, garage sales, fireworks and community cabaret. Watch for more information.

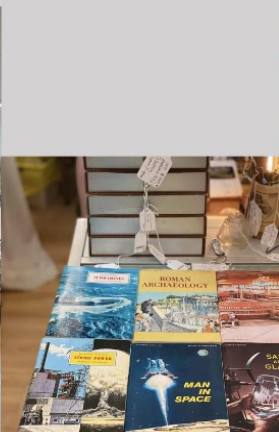
Yesterday's Treasure Market

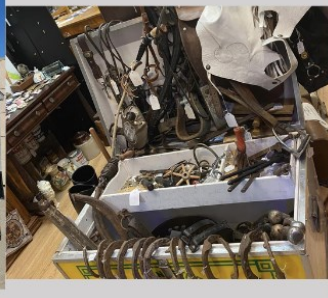

PARADE COMMENCES @ 11:00 AM SATURDAY, AUGUST 19, 2023

The Parade route begins at the Calmar Elementary School. All entries will line up facing South on 50th Street.

You are invited to submit your application early due to limited space. The Town of Calmar reserves the right to reject any entry deemed not suitable for this event.

RULES & REGULATIONS

All participants must comply for both the participants and the spectator's safety!

Marshalling starts @ 9:00 am along 50 street facing south starting at the Calmar Elementary School.

Animal entries are requested to unload in the field in front the Elementary School

1. All entries are to be lined up by 10:30 AM - to ensure proper placement in the lineup;
2. Distribution of Candy or other treats must be peanut free and wrapped. CANNOT BE THROWN.
3. All vehicles must be clean and decorated to a minimum of 80%. Float tow vehicles must be clean and tastefully decorated to complement the rest of the entries. (Exceptions made for antique vehicles).
4. Protective equipment, including helmets, must be worn for anyone operating bicycles, motorcycles and off-road vehicles.
5. Smoking is NOT permitted on or near floats or motorized entries.
6. Entries must continue to the completion of the parade route unless special circumstances arise.
