



CALMAR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

Coming soon - Tips and information on what to do if an emergency occurs will be added as a drop down menu to the **Emergency Management** tab on our website.

Calmar will be launching the **Registered Reception**Centre Program (RRCP). Instruction and usage will be presented in an open house scheduled for July 12, 2024.

RRCP monitors the movement of families from one facility or region to another, ensuring evacuees are accounted for during a large-scale or complex emergency.

The new online registration system will also be used for emergencies that do not require an evacuation.

Shelter-in-place emergencies may include a hazardous material spill, train derailment, active shooter in the area, or a storm that has caused a power outage or debris on the road.

Residents will be able to register themselves and their pets.

Property Taxes

The Town offers a penalty free payment plan specially for Tax Accounts.

You can sign up anytime throughout the year, but you will need to pay up front for the months that have already passed to stay caught up.

All you need is a signed Pre-Authorized Debit form and a VOID Cheque/Direct Deposit form from your bank. No more missed due dates and penalties, and no need to renew every year. Just an automatic withdrawal from your account once a month.

The payment is calculated based on your most current levy.
