Reminder to all to adventure out on July 1 and see the 2nd Annual Canada Cup


Street hockey tournament. Come on down to the free pancake breakfast and all kinds of fun for all ages.

Our mental health affects how we feel, how we think and how we act. It's important to take care of ourselves and know where to find help when we, or someone else, needs it.

Supporting positive mental health

What can you do today? Here's some ideas:

- Feel your feelings, they may have something important to tell you.
- · Get some fresh air or some exercise.
- Call a friend to say hi or meet up for coffee.
- Take some deep breaths or meditate.
- Try something new.
- Spend time doing something you especially enjoy.

If you know someone who is struggling or if you're feeling overwhelmed yourself, it is important to reach out for support.

Helping others

Are you concerned about someone you care about?

Signs that someone may need help:

- consistently expressing sadness or hopelessness
- unable to concentrate or focus
- constantly exhausted
- unusual irritability

How you can help:

- Ask the person what they need.
- Ask if they have someone they can talk to, such as a friend, spouse or doctor.
- Help raise awareness about mental health every conversation counts!

How do you find out what resources and supports are available if you have never had to ask for help? When times are tough, sometimes the first step is to prevent them from getting worse. There are

various resources available depending on what you're going through. No matter what it is, help is available.


