We are currently accepting the following products for recycling in the Blue Bag:

- * Newsprint/Computer/Mixed Paper
- * Cardboard
- * Tin cans
- * Plastic jugs w/o screw top lids
- * Rigid plastic containers
- * NO STYROFOAM
- * NO STRAWS/PLASTIC UTENSILS
- * NO PLASTIC BAGS

Pick up is every second Monday



SPRING / FALL CLEAN UP

The Town collects large household items to a maximum of 1/2 tonne per residence in May and October.

The Town *will not* accept the following:

- * Dishwashers
- * Refrigerators/Deepfreezes
- * Microwaves/Stoves
- * Washers/Dryers
- * Broken Glass
- * Batteries
- * Car Parts/Tires
- * Paint/Oil/Chemicals/Propane

Metal and bundled (3 ft) wood should be in separate



ORGANIC WASTE

Residents can place grass clippings and yard waste in **CLEAR NON-COLOURED** bags for collection.

Every Monday in May - October

Curbside front yard pick up only.

Please ensure branches are in 3 ft. bundles, and placed with your clear bags.

Calmar Bottle Depot Ltd. accepts all bottles and cans. They also accept all liquid milk product containers. Please "swish & squish" your containers.

Summer (Beginning of May until mid September)

- Mon, Tue, Thu, Fri, Sat - 9:00 am to 5:00 pm
- Wednesday - 9:00 am to 9:00 pm

Winter (Mid September until the end of April)

- Monday to Saturday - 9:00 am to 5:00 pm
- Sunday Closed

Statutory Holidays - Open every holiday with the exception of Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Years Day.

The member municipalities of the Leduc and District Waste Management Facility have implemented a **Resident Identification Card** system at the Leduc and District Regional Waste Management Facility. By implementing the Resident Identification Card system, the member municipalities of the Leduc and District Regional Waste Management Facility anticipate a reduction of abuse by non-residents of the member municipalities and hope to allow their residents continued use of the landfill for household waste without implementing facility usage fees. **The member municipalities include the City of Leduc, County of Leduc, the Town Of Beaumont, the Town of Devon and the Town of Calmar.**

If you are a resident and wish to sign up for a Resident Card, you can so in two ways:

- 1) Going online and filling out the application. The online application can take up to two weeks to process and receive your card by mail.
- 2) The other option is to go to our Scale House and fill out the application with a 24 hour activation period.

If you are a resident of these member municipalities, you will be able to use the facility to dispose of 1 tonne (1000 kg) of household waste per year without being personally charged at the scale house upon exiting the facility provided you are able to produce a Leduc and District Waste Management Facility Resident Identification Card.
