<u>The Town of Calmar</u> offers an affordable, accessible alternative to urban living, just 16 km southwest of Edmonton along Highway 39, with direct access to the QEII and Edmonton International Airport in 20 minutes. Calmar is perfect for regional work.

Affordable homes come with all the amenities you need, from shops to parks, without any of the big-city trade-offs.

The community also supports families with its schools and programs, including Alberta's first LEED-certified elementary, a modern health centre, and over 20 hectares of parkland with 10+ km of trails.

Industries like oilfield services and manufacturing provide steady jobs, while Main Street's shops and annual events like Calmar Days support a balanced lifestyle for residents and businesses.

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
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Why It's Time to Leave the City

City life may have its draws, but many are reconsidering...

- Out of Reach Housing Costs: Home prices in urban centers like Edmonton have risen 12.1% year-over-year, making it harder for families to afford suitable homes.
- <u>Time Lost in Stop-and-Go City Traffic</u>: Congested urban traffic in cities adds an average of 21% to travel times, slowing daily trips for errands or leisure and cutting into time for personal priorities.
- <u>Limited Space</u>: Population density is up to 4x higher in urban areas. Tight homes and crowded public areas make finding room for calm or comfort difficult.
- <u>Noise Pollution</u>: Urban background noise in cities, often exceeding a constant 55 decibels from traffic or crowds, increases stress and disrupts sleep, impacting well-being.

- <u>Affordable Living</u>: Calmar's housing market supports homeownership with competitive prices and wider streets.



Summer Activities

Enjoy diverse summer activities that support an active, family-oriented lifestyle, with convenient options for residents to enjoy both locally and nearby.

In Town

- <u>Walking</u> and <u>Biking</u>: Paved urban trails provide routes for walking or cycling, through neighborhoods, promoting daily exercise.
- <u>Park Picnics</u>: Engberg Spray Park and Calmar Elementary's playground offer shaded areas and kid-friendly spaces for family gatherings.
- <u>Community Events</u>: Canada Day, Resident Appreciation BBQ, and other summer events offer free food, games, and family activities.

Within 30 Minutes

- <u>Golfing</u>: RedTail Landing Golf Club provides an 18-hole course and driving range for recreational and social outings.
- <u>Lakes</u>: Wizard Lake offers fishing and boating, including water skiing, while Telford Lake supports paddleboarding and kayaking.
- <u>Rivers</u>: The nearby North Saskatchewan River provides additional opportunities for water activities, such as kayaking and scenic riverside walks.
- Shopping: Leduc's retail centers offer convenient access to stores and services.

Day Trips

- <u>Kayaking and Canoeing</u>: Pigeon Lake, less than an hour away, features calm waters for paddling, perfect for family adventures.
- <u>Cowboy Trail</u>: A scenic route showcasing Alberta's foothills, perfect for a leisurely drive to connect with the region's heritage.
- <u>Brazeau Dam</u>: A 40-minute drive west, this reservoir offers boating and fishing for pike and trout, adding to Calmar's recreational reach.
- Crown Land and Provincial Parks: Explore nearby crown land for hiking, camping, or off-road adventures, or visit provincial parks like Pigeon Lake Provincial Park, less than an hour away, for family-friendly trails, picnics, and wildlife viewing.



Winter Activities

Calmar provides a range of winter activities that support active lifestyles, offering residents convenient options both locally and nearby.

In Town

- <u>Skating and Hockey:</u> The Mike Karbonik Arena hosts minor and elite hockey, figure skating, public skating, and shinny, with a top-rated concession.
- <u>Calmar Curling Club:</u> Adjacent to the arena, this facility offers curling leagues and social events.
- <u>Community Events:</u> Christmas in the Park, First Night Celebration, and other winter events provide free food, games, and family activities.

Within 30 Minutes

- <u>Cross-Country Skiing and Snowshoeing:</u> Trails near Wizard Lake provide accessible routes, perfect for residents seeking outdoor activity.
- <u>Lakes</u>: Wizard Lake supports ice fishing for walleye, perch, and pike, offering a peaceful pastime close to home.
- Holiday Displays: Christmas Magic of Lights at RAD Torque Raceway and Leduc County Country Lights off Highway 39 provide festive family outings.

Day Trips

- <u>Pigeon Lake:</u> Pigeon Lake, less than an hour away, features calm waters for paddling, perfect for family adventures.
- Skiing at Rabbit Hill: Just about 20 minutes away, this hill offers great slopes and winter exploration for extended adventures.
- Northern Lights Viewing: On clear winter nights, find a spot away from town lights to potentially see the aurora borealis.



Festivals & Events

Free Friday drive-in movie with popcorn. Saturday brings pancakes, a parade, market sales, and local art with Zyp Gallery and Calmar Art Club.

Marks the start of summer with free BBQ, chips, and children's games, plus lemonade from local businesses. A movie in the park closes the evening.

Canada Day Celebration

Held at Engberg Spray Park, featuring free hot dogs, refreshments, cake, games for young children, and open spray park access.



Housing in Calmar

<u>Calmar's housing market</u> offers an affordable, spacious, and growing environment, ideal for families, retirees, and professionals seeking value and opportunity.



- Competitive Costs: Home prices remain lower than in nearby urban centers, making homeownership accessible for first-time buyers and growing families.
- Spacious Design: Wider streets and generous lot sizes provide room to breathe, improving daily comfort and neighborhood appeal.
- Residential Growth: With 30 housing starts in 2024, reflecting a 4% household growth rate, Calmar is expanding to welcome new residents while maintaining its small-town charm.
- Stable Market: Of 915 total households, 80.9% (740) are homeowners and 19.1% (175) are renters, with an average household size of 2.4 people, offering a balanced foundation for new development.
- Varied Options: The Leduc Regional Housing Foundation supports varied needs with seniors' housing, single-family homes, detached units, subsidized rentals, and rent supplements, ensuring choices for all budgets.



<u>These features position Calmar</u> as a practical and promising choice for residents and businesses looking for affordability and growth potential.

Facilities

Calmar's facilities provide robust support for education, health, and recreation, creating an appealing environment for residents and businesses seeking quality and accessibility.

- Educational Institutions: Three schools serve the area, including:
 - Calmar Elementary (Alberta's first LEED-certified school).
 - Calmar Secondary (rebuilt with modern upgrades, an apprenticeship wing for Grade 12 trades training, and a collegiate addition opening fall 2025).
 - New Humble Community School (10 minutes south), offering comprehensive learning options.
- <u>Childcare Services</u>: Two centres provide reliable daycare, supporting working families and young children's development.
- <u>Healthcare Access</u>: A modern health centre delivers family medicine, chiropractic, ophthalmology, massage therapy, and dental care, meeting diverse medical needs.
- <u>Recreational Spaces</u>: Plenty of parkland, including Centre Park and Woodland Park, features playgrounds and event spaces, complemented by non-motorized, multi-use trails for walking and cycling.


