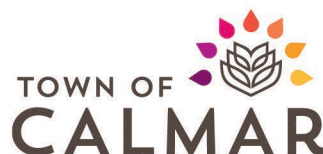

Assumption of Risks

I am aware that participating in volleyball, pickleball, and related recreational activities offered by or associated with the TOWN OF CALMAR involves inherent risks, dangers, and hazards. These may include, without limitation, slips, trips, falls, collisions with other participants, contact with balls, paddles, nets, posts, gym floors, court surfaces, and other equipment, overexertion, strains, sprains, fractures, illness, personal injury, death, property damage, or loss. By participating, I freely accept and fully assume all inherent risks, dangers, and hazards arising from or related to my participation.

Age and Spectator Policy

The TOWN OF CALMAR volleyball and pickleball drop-in programs are open to participants 16 years of age and older. Participants who are 16 or 17 years of age must have permission from a parent or legal guardian to participate. By permitting a minor to participate, the parent or legal guardian confirms that the minor is able to participate safely and accepts responsibility for the minor's participation, conduct, supervision, and safety while attending the program. Participants are discouraged from bringing underage spectators to any TOWN OF CALMAR program held in a gymnasium, on a court, or at any other recreation venue. These are active play areas where balls, paddles, participants, and equipment may move quickly and unpredictably. If a parent, guardian, or supervisor brings an underage spectator to a TOWN OF CALMAR recreation venue, they do so at their own risk and assume full responsibility for that minor's care, supervision, safety, and conduct.



Release of Liability Waiver of Claims & Indemnity Agreement

In consideration of the TOWN OF CALMAR permitting me to participate in its activities, use its equipment, and use its facilities, I agree as follows:

TO WAIVE any and all claims that I have or may in the future have against the TOWN OF CALMAR and its directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives, assigns, and successors.

TO RELEASE the TOWN OF CALMAR and its directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives, assigns, and successors from any and all liability for any loss, damage, injury, or expense that I or my next of kin may suffer as a result of my participation in activities offered by or facilitated by the TOWN OF CALMAR, due to any cause whatsoever, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE, BREACH OF CONTRACT, BREACH OF STATUTORY DUTY OF CARE, AND/OR BREACH OF THE OCCUPIERS' LIABILITY ACT, R.S.A. 2000, c. O-4, on the part of the TOWN OF CALMAR and its directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives, assigns, and successors.

TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY the TOWN OF CALMAR and its directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives, assigns, and successors from any and all liability for any property damage or personal injury to any third party resulting from my participation in activities offered by or associated with the TOWN OF CALMAR.

TO FOREVER RELEASE AND INDEMNIFY the TOWN OF CALMAR from any claims, liability, loss, damage, injury, or expense arising from or related to exposure to or infection by communicable illness, including illness that may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself, other participants, or the TOWN OF CALMAR.

This Agreement shall be effective and binding upon my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, and assigns in the event of my death.

I have read and understood this Agreement before signing it. I understand that by signing this Agreement, or by checking the waiver box on the registration page, I am waiving certain legal rights that I or my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, and assigns may have against the TOWN OF CALMAR and its directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives, assigns, and successors.
